



UPDATE ON THE JOHNSTOWN INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Johnstown, PA -(August 27, 2025) The Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) is providing the following update for work completed on The Johnstown Inclined Plane Rehabilitation Project in August 2025.

AUGUST 2025 – THE INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION UPDATE:

- Automation programming was successfully completed. As previously reported, this phase was complex and time-consuming.
- Auxiliary drive testing was conducted. This testing was successful as it proved the drive would power the inclined plane cars as intended. This testing was completed with loaded and unloaded cars.
- Contractors continued to perform preliminary testing on system components.
- Electrical contractors completed modifications to the north and south trolley wires. The trolley wire is responsible for providing power to the inclined plane cars.

SEPTEMBER 2025 – THE INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION LOOK AHEAD:

- Installation of the new safety and haul cables is scheduled to begin on Sept. 2nd; this work will result in the closure of Edgehill Dr for a period of two (2) weeks.
- Comprehensive system testing will continue.
- All contractors will continue to finish remaining work in preparation for commissioning.

Asiago's restaurant, located in the Inclined Plane's Visitor's Center, remains open throughout the duration of the project.
