



UPDATE ON THE JOHNSTOWN INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION PROJECT

For Immediate Release:

Johnstown, PA - (May 20, 2026) The Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) is providing the following update for work completed on The Johnstown Inclined Plane Rehabilitation Project in May 2026.

May 2026 – The Inclined Plane Rehabilitation Update:

- Work on the trolley wire continues:
 - All unused trolley wire clamps were removed.
 - The remaining clamps were adjusted.
 - The lower station counterweights are installed.
- The Department of Labor & Industry (L&I) is scheduled to return to the Inclined Plane on May 28, 2026.

Next Steps:

- If the Inclined Plane passes the L&I certification process, it will trigger the start of the 30-day maintenance period.
- In accordance with state requirements, all maintenance work will be completed by staff during a 30-day period before the State Safety Oversight (SSO) Program returns to conduct final testing. Once the Incline successfully passes pre-revenue testing, approval will be granted to reopen to the public.
- Operator and Conductor training will be scheduled and conducted concurrently with the 30-day maintenance period.
- A reopening date will be confirmed after final inspections, and all required training has been completed.

Asiago's Tuscan Italian restaurant, located in the Inclined Plane's Visitor's Center, remains open throughout the duration of the project.
