



UPDATE ON THE JOHNSTOWN INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Johnstown, PA -(December 30, 2025) The Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) is providing the following update for work completed on The Johnstown Inclined Plane Rehabilitation Project in December 2025.

December 2025 – THE INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION UPDATE:

- Bumper pad installation at the lower station was completed.
- The geometry of the west haul brake was adjusted, and new brake pads were installed at the shop. Once this work was completed, the west haul brake was returned to the Inclined Plane and reinstalled. Preliminary system operation following reinstallation identified no deficiencies in the brake band or associated component. These components will continue to be monitored as testing continues.
- Routine maintenance work was conducted on electrical components of the 400 hp motor that powers the Incline.
- Work continued toward resolving punch list items that were identified during commissioning. This work is anticipated to be completed within the next two (2) weeks.
- Cleanup of the gift shop continues.

Asiago's restaurant, located in the Inclined Plane's Visitor's Center, remains open throughout the duration of the project.
