



UPDATE ON THE JOHNSTOWN INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Johnstown, PA -(February 27, 2026) The Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) is providing the following update for work completed on The Johnstown Incline Rehabilitation Project in February 2026.

February 2026 – THE INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION UPDATE:

- The new safety sheave bearing cap was installed.
- The Haul brake torque training was performed with the Incline Plane maintenance staff.
- Working on the safety gate so it operates as intended.

Next Steps:

- L & I will be scheduled to return to Incline once final equipment testing is completed.
- In accordance with state requirements, all maintenance work will be completed by staff during a 30-day period before the State Safety Oversight Office (SSO) returns to conduct final testing. Once the Incline successfully passes inspection, approval will be granted to reopen to the public.
- Operator and Conductor training will be scheduled and conducted concurrently with the 30-day maintenance period.
- A reopening date will be confirmed after final inspections, and all required training has been completed.

Asiago’s restaurant, located in the Incline Plane’s Visitor’s Center, remains open throughout the duration of the project.
