Edgehill Drive Reopens -Upcoming Temporary Closure Scheduled

Johnstown, PA — The Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) is pleased to announce that Edgehill Drive, located in front of the Inclined Plane Station, has reopened to traffic as of this afternoon.

Upcoming Temporary Closure:

A scheduled temporary closure will take place from **Monday, May 19 through Wednesday, May 21**, from **7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily**.

Closure Details:

- **Closed Area:** The middle portion of Edgehill Drive in front of the Inclined Plane Gift Shop.
- **Inaccessible Locations:** Steps from Edgehill Drive to the Mound, and the Observation/Waiting Deck.
- **Open After Hours:** Edgehill Drive and all affected areas will reopen each evening after 5:00 p.m.

Restaurant Access:

- **Asiago's Restaurant** at the Visitor's Center will remain **open during regular business hours**.
- Vehicle and pedestrian access to the restaurant will **not be impacted**, and **parking will remain available** along Edgehill Drive.

These temporary closures are essential to ensure the safety of both the public and on-site workers as work continues on the rehabilitation project.

CamTran appreciates the community's continued patience and support as we work diligently toward the reopening of the Johnstown Inclined Plane.
