

JOHNSTOWN INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION PROJECT

CamTran Announces Temporary Daily Closures -Portion of Edgehill Drive for Construction Work

Johnstown, PA — The Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) is notifying the public of a temporary daily closure of a portion of Edgehill Drive beginning **Monday, May 5** through **Friday, May 30**, from **7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** each day. The affected section will reopen daily after 5:00 p.m.

Rose M. Lucey-Noll, Executive Director, stated, "This closure is necessary to safely complete essential work on the Johnstown Inclined Plane, including reinstalling the decking and installing and wiring the Operator's Booth on the platform. For public safety, access will be restricted during work hours."

Closure Details:

- Closed Area: The middle portion of Edgehill Drive in front of the Inclined Plane Gift Shop.
- Inaccessible Locations: Steps from Edgehill Drive to the Mound, and the Observation/Waiting Deck.
- Open After Hours: Edgehill Drive and all affected areas will reopen each evening after 5:00 p.m.

Restaurant Access:

- Asiago's Restaurant at the Visitor's Center will remain open during regular business hours.
- Vehicle and pedestrian access to the restaurant will **not be impacted**, and **parking will remain available** along Edgehill Drive.

CamTran has completed the reinstallation of the main haul and safety sheave wheels. The General Contractor is returning to finishing their portion of the project.

CamTran remains committed to public safety and appreciates the community's patience as we work toward reopening the Inclined Plane.
