UPDATE: Road Closure September 2nd through September 12th

CamTran Announces Temporary Road Closure -Inclined Plane Gift Shop to Erie St. for rope replacement work

Johnstown, PA (August 25, 2025.) The Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) is notifying the public of <u>a continuous road closure</u> to a portion of Edgehill Drive from Tuesday, September 2 at 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Friday September 12th.

Robert Johnson, Chief Operations Officer of CamTran, stated: "This closure is necessary to replace the safety and haul ropes of the inclined plane. To ensure public safety, access to the work site surrounding the Johnstown Inclined Plane will be restricted."

Closure Details:

- Closed Area: The area immediately adjacent to the Inclined Plane Gift Shop on Edgehill Drive to Erie St.
- Inaccessible Locations: Steps from Edgehill Drive to the Mound and the Observation/Waiting Deck.
- Hours of Closure: Continuous closure 6:00 a.m. September 2nd through September 12th at 5:00 p.m.

Restaurant Access:

- Asiago's Restaurant at the Visitor's Center will remain open during regular business hours.
- Vehicle and pedestrian access to the restaurant will **not be impacted**, and **parking will remain available** along Edgehill Drive.

CamTran remains committed to public safety and appreciates the community's patience as we work toward reopening The Inclined Plane.
