CamTran Update on Inclined Plane Rehabilitation Project

Johnstown, Pa (May 6, 2024) – CamTran issued the following statement on the status of the Johnstown Inclined Plane Rehabilitation project.

Following an investigation by Conroy Engineering, an independent company hired by CamTran, it's been determined that errors occurred in the fabrication of the rims on the main haul and safety sheave wheels. As a result, the time it will take to re-fabricate the rims and undertake commissioning with the PA Rail Safety Oversight, Department of Labor & Industry, and operator/conductor training, the Inclined Plane will not re-open in 2024.

The goal has been and remains to re-open the Incline to the public so it operates in a safe manner and fulfills its commitment to ensure longevity and durability of the Incline for many years to come.
