



UPDATE ON THE JOHNSTOWN INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Johnstown, PA -(July 28, 2025) The Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) is providing the following update for work completed on The Johnstown Inclined Plane Rehabilitation Project in July 2025.

JULY 2025 – THE INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION UPDATE:

- On July 2nd, the Inclined Plane cars were untied and successfully moved. This movement confirmed that the system operates as intended and is compatible with the original design specifications, marking a major step forward in the rehabilitation project.
- Following the successful movement of the cars, contractors began work on installing the automation phase of the project. This phase is complex and time-consuming, involving the installation of sensors on the braking systems, gate mechanisms, and both the emergency power and is expected to continue through the end of July.
- Contractors also performed preliminary testing on system components that are currently ready for evaluation.

AUGUST 2025 – THE INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION LOOK AHEAD:

- Installation of the new safety and haul cables is scheduled for mid to late August.
- Completion of automation programming.
- Comprehensive system testing.

Asiago's restaurant, located in the Inclined Plane's Visitor's Center, remains open throughout the duration of the project.
