



## **UPDATE ON THE JOHNSTOWN INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION PROJECT**

**Johnstown, PA** -(November 7, 2025) The Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) is providing the following update for work completed on The Johnstown Inclined Plane Rehabilitation Project in October 2025.

### **OCTOBER 2025 – THE INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION UPDATE:**

- Labor & Industry (L&I) Commissioning took place on October 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> with a few items that will need follow-up and reinspected by L&I prior to entering revenue service.
- PA Rail State Safety Oversight (SSO) Commissioning occurred on October 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> with no follow-up items.
- HNTB (Engineer of Record) performed an inspection of the rails and ties with no issues.
- HNTB and GFT (CM) conducted an inspection and signed off on the new auxiliary motor automation system.
- The new wire ropes were lubricated.
- New shatter resistant glass was installed at the visitor center motor room window, electrical room door and the gift shop motor room window.
- Replaced wooded mounting for the undercarriage rocker switches with nonconductive material.
- Edgehill Drive was repaved from Visitor’s Center to Erie Street.
- Installed the auxiliary drive torque test collar.

**Asiago’s restaurant, located in The Inclined Plane’s Visitor’s Center, remains open throughout the duration of the project.**
