



UPDATE ON THE JOHNSTOWN INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Johnstown, PA -(September 29, 2025) The Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) is providing the following update for work completed on The Johnstown Inclined Plane Rehabilitation Project in September 2025.

SEPTEMBER 2025 – THE INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION UPDATE:

- Safety and haul rope replacement was completed.
- Comprehensive system testing continued.
- Additional automation programming occurred.
- Modifications were made to the braking system.
- Contractors arrived on site to continue gate work on both cars as well as upper and lower stations.

OCTOBER 2025 – THE INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION LOOK AHEAD:

- Comprehensive system testing will continue.
- All contractors will continue to finish remaining work in preparation for commissioning.
- Commissioning is scheduled to begin October 13th.
- Once commissioning is successfully completed, CamTran will immediately move forward with pre-revenue testing and employee training.

Asiago's restaurant, located in The Inclined Plane's Visitor's Center, remains open throughout the duration of the project.
